


<b>Scholarship Name</b>	<b>Dr Sitaleki Finau</b>
<b>Scholarship Description</b>	Awarded to an indigenous Pacific medical trainee in the sub-speciality of Public Health training, with a specific interest in community-led research that produces compelling evidential leverage to implement appropriate public health projects for the Pasifika community
<b>Quantity and Amount of Awards</b>	One award to the value of \$10,000
<b>Eligibility Criteria</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Be of an indigenous Pacific ethnic group.</li> <li>• Be a New Zealand resident - Citizen or Permanent Resident.</li> <li>• Must be in a formal public health training programme and preferably in the 1<sup>st</sup> or 2<sup>nd</sup> year of training at any local or international college. Research will be a requirement for the scholarship.</li> <li>• Demonstrate experience in community leadership or aspirations to become a leader in their community.</li> <li>• Provide evidence of good standing in the community (2 x reference letters from a non-relative or family acquaintance).</li> </ul>
<b>Conditions of Acceptance</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Be available and willing to participate in PMA events and activities.</li> <li>• Agree to attend at least one PMA event per year over the course of their studies.</li> <li>• Agree to have their photo taken for scholarship promotional and communications purposes, and PMA reports.</li> <li>• Be engaged in the work of the PMA group.</li> <li>• Agree to participate in and receive mentorship, cultural and pastoral supervision from a mentor appointed by PMA.</li> <li>• Provide progress updates and report at the end of every academic year.</li> <li>• Advise PMA of any changes in study situation and contact details during their period of study.</li> </ul>
